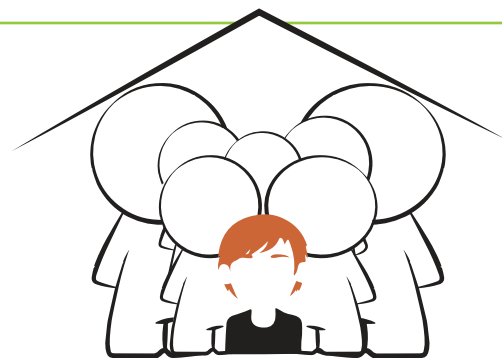


Helping families organize their village after a sudden loss.

- Funeral home meetings can last up to three hours, so eat before you go.
- Once you leave the hospital, you may not see your loved one again until the visitation.
- Many families choose to donate vital organs. Time is critical in deciding to donate. You have only 24 hours in most cases to make a possible life saving decision. You must be prepared to answer medical related questions from the medical examiner's office.
