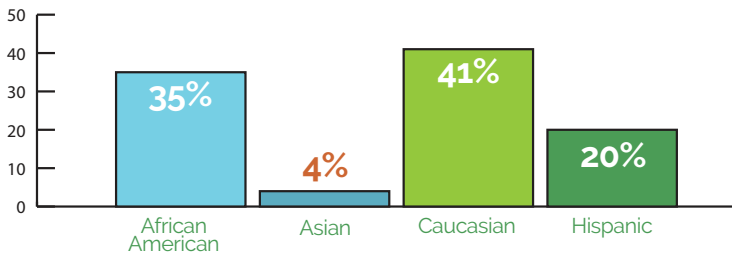

Ethnicities of Families Supported To Date:

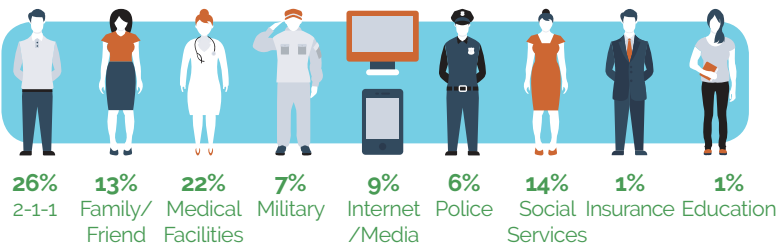
