
2024 Carson's Village Annual Review

Direct Support


Helping families immediately after a loss.

Through our Direct and Continuing Support Services **families are connected to a system of care** that not only provides immediate support for loss but also **helps families move towards healing and hope**.

Direct Support Narrative

Learn how we provided immediate support to Shirley's family after their loss.

Shirley's family was referred to Carson's Village by a hospice social worker after their loved one passed away from cancer. Financial constraints made covering end-of-life expenses a significant challenge. The family sought guidance on options to honor their loved one with dignity.

With the support of a Carson's Village Advocate, the family received:

- · Pricing information for local funeral homes,
- A personalized family support page, and
- · Guidance on notifying the necessary agencies and organizations.

The family was also made aware of the option to donate their loved one's body—an alternative that allowed them to honor their loved one's wishes while alleviating financial strain.

The family expressed immense gratitude for the opportunity to help others through body donation, avoid unnecessary debt, and eliminate high funeral costs. This option provided peace of mind and a sense of purpose during a difficult time.

The family was thankful for Carson's Village support in guiding them through planning and grieving while connecting them to resources they otherwise would not have known.

Continuing Support Narrative

How Peer-to-Peer Support Made a Difference for Li.

After losing her son to a sudden and tragic accident, Li was left shocked, heartbroken, and unsure of where to turn. While in the ER, a social worker shared information about Carson's Village, which became a lifeline for her.

Once her Advocate assisted with immediate needs like funeral planning and addressing mental health concerns, Li was connected to a Peer-to-Peer Villager, Sophy—a fellow grieving mother who had lost her child four years earlier. Sophy became a pillar of support, walking alongside Li throughout her grieving journey. She spent hours on the phone with Li, exchanged countless text messages, and, most importantly, shared the weight of grief as Li's "grieving sister."

In addition, Li was paired with Chuck, a father who also experienced the loss of a child. Chuck regularly checked in with Li, offering his time, support, and a compassionate ear whenever she needed someone to listen.

The Carson's Village community of grieving parents continued to stand by Li, reaching out on meaningful days like her son's birthday, Mother's Day, Father's Day, and other holidays—ensuring she never felt alone.

Reflecting on her experience, Li shares:

"They [Carson's Village Advocates and Villagers] have become part of our family to some extent. The selfless love, care, and support from Carson's Village have been the light in our darkest nights, providing a special understanding and comfort that no one else on this planet could offer, and hope for grieving parents like us to live on. Carson's Village is the home for broken-hearted grieving parents. We were lucky that we had and still have this home in the darkest days of our lives, and for many more years to come. I hope that there is no more grieving parents' tears on this planet."
